Dear Parents,

Year 3 School Trip – London Eye and River Cruise Tuesday 10th September 2019

As part of the launch of the Urban Pioneers Integrated Learning Project, we have booked for Year 3 to go on a river cruise on the Thames, to look at the London skyline, buildings and features and then to go on the London Eye to gain perspective of a city from a great height and to begin to think about geographical features and aerial photographs. The idea is for children to capture photos and film footage of the city to engage them in the learning project. There may also be some time to see some of the architecture, art and street theatre of the South Bank.

The itinerary is as follows:

9:00 Depart school. Time on the Southbank on arrival
11:00 River cruise departing adjacent to London Eye (departs 11:30)
12:30 Lunch in Jubilee gardens/ time on Southbank
1:00 London Eye Experience
2:15 Leave to return to school
3.25 Expected time of return to school (traffic dependent)

This trip will be led by Mrs. Clarke and supported by other members of the staff team. We would however ask if there are any parents who may be able to volunteer to join this trip that you complete Google Form from the following link:

We will then contact you to confirm your attendance.

The cost of this trip will be £24 per pupil which covers the cost of the attractions and transport. Parents are asked to make a voluntary payment for this trip via ParentPay against payment item “Year 3 School Trip – London Eye and River Cruise” as soon as possible but by the end of the month at the latest.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch from home in a rucksack that your child can comfortably carry during the day. They will be responsible for their bags throughout the trip. Please note that under no circumstances should your child’s lunch contain nuts, fizzy drinks or glass bottles. Please also

supply a bottle of water and healthy snack. Please do not order a school lunch for Tuesday 10th September.

We have no doubt that the children will thoroughly enjoy this trip and which will support the Year 3 curriculum learning and our commitment to the Urban Pioneer Integrated Learning Project. It will provide an ideal opportunity for the children to develop their understanding of the city's architecture and features.

As with any trip the children will be representing the school and exemplary behaviour is expected at all times.
