Year 3 School Visit – Institut Français, South Kensington. Tuesday 19th November 2019

As part of our bilingual curriculum Year 3 children (Beale and Carlile classes), we have planned an exciting French day at the Institut Français. We will be watching the latest Asterix: le secret de la potion magique. /Asterix: the secret of the magic potion animation in the beautiful Art Deco Cinéma Lumière. The film is in French with English subtitles. Certificate: U.

We will also be visiting the Bibliothèque Quentin Blake/ *the* Quentin Blake library which is part of the same building. Where we will, hopefully, hear from a French author.

We will be leaving by coach at **8am, therefore children will need to arrive at school by 7.45am for registration.** We will be leaving London at 2pm to return to school by 3.30pm (traffic permitting).

The cost of this trip will be £8.50 per pupil which covers the cost of the transport. All the activities at the Institut Français are free, thanks to the Film Festival of Intofilm.org and the support we receive as a LabelFrancéducation award school. Parents are asked to make a voluntary payment for this visit via ParentPay against payment item "Year 3 School Visit – Institut Français " as soon as possible.

This visit will be led by Mme. Chadier and supported by other members of the staff team. We would however ask if there are any parents who may be able to volunteer to join this visit that you email our school at office@stjeromebilingual.org

The children will need to bring a packed lunch from home in a rucksack that your child can comfortably carry during the day. They will be responsible for their bags throughout the visit. Please note that under no circumstances should your child's lunch contain nuts, fizzy drinks

or glass bottles. Please also supply a bottle of water and a healthy snack. Please do not order a school lunch for Tuesday 19th November.

We have no doubt that the children will thoroughly enjoy this visit which will support the Year 3 curriculum learning. It will provide an ideal opportunity for the children to perhaps see a film in French for the first time.

As with any visit the children will be representing the school and exemplary behaviour is expected at all times.
