We hope everyone has had a lovely first half of Michaelmas term. It has been a pleasure to get to know our new classes and work on our 'Urban Pioneers' topic.

As well as taking time to rest and relax, we would like children to keep reading as much as possible. Children have their school reading book but can, of course, read books from the library or home. When reading with the children, please ask questions to check for understanding and ask them to summarise the main points. It would also be great for children to practise their handwriting skills (letters as well as numbers) using the letterjoin website.

In addition, please continue to use Mathletics, we have resent user names and passwords for this today. Children remember best when they learn or practise small chunks regularly, rather than a large amount in one session.

Throughout the rest of the year, we will set maths activities for the children to complete on a weekly basis through the Mathletics website. These activities will serve to consolidate our work in class as well as review previous learning. Teachers will be regularly checking that work has been completed by the children.

We have also issued homework as usual in the homework books but we are aware that some families will be away and everyone needs a break, so please just complete as much as you feel is necessary.
