Dear Parents / Carers,

Year 3 Netball Club Epiphany (Spring) Term

We are delighted to be able to offer the children in Year 3 the opportunity to attend a Netball club, which will be led by Miss Saleh and Miss Tomlin our Year 1 teachers. This club is available to both boys and girls and is designed to introduce the children to the game of Netball through a structured age appropriate programme.

The club will run after school each Monday from Monday 13th January 2020 until and including Monday 23rd March 2020 from 3:25pm until 4:30pm at a cost £7 per session per child for a total of 10 weeks, totalling £70 payable in advance.

Children will be collected from their classrooms after lessons, where they will change (suitable sports clothes must be provided from home each week). The club will take place in the playground unless the weather is wet then the club will take place in the school hall. Please ensure your child's water bottle is in school.

Your child must be collected promptly at 4:30pm, from the **school playground** unless they are attending After School Club when they should be collected from the usual place before 6pm.

The booking process will be online via ParentPay. We expect a continued high level of interest in this club and places will be limited to a maximum of 20 pupils. If you would like to secure a place for your child, booking and payment must be made via ParentPay before commencement of the first session. Places will be allocated strictly on a first come first served basis.

To make a booking: Please log onto your ParentPay account; select the payment item entitled "Y3 Netball Spring 2020" and proceed to payment. The booking page will 'go live' on ParentPay from noon on Tuesday 7th January 2020. Once the club is full you will not be able to make payment.

Please note that this club can only operate if there is sufficient interest and that the children can only attend if full payment has been made. The school has to commit to honour the invoices to the provider, therefore refunds for non-attendance for any reason cannot be sustained.

As with all our extra-curricular clubs, exemplary behaviour is expected from the children and if we have any cause for concern the school reserves the right to withdraw any child from the club.

If your family is in receipt of Universal Credit and would like to apply for financial assistance towards the cost of these activities, then please email the school office before Tuesday 7th January 2020. You can be assured of complete discretion and sensitivity at all times.

We trust the children will enjoy the club and should you have any questions at all please contact the school office from Monday 6th January 2020.
