Year 2 Visit to Kenton Recreation Ground

We are delighted to announce, that on Friday 6th March 2020, we have planned a visit to Kenton Recreation Ground for Year 2.

The visit has been chosen to link with the Year 2 topic Wriggle and Crawl in which the children will learn to describe a range of local habitats and habitats beyond their locality. They will learn that all living things live in a habitat to which they are suited and it must provide everything they need to survive.

The children will leave school at 1:15pm and return to school to be collected at 3pm. They will be supervised by members of staff at all times and both staff and children will wear high visibility vests.
