

How to get started

1. Go to:
<https://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/saintjerome/?test=t1&cat=cause-autosuggest&q=st%20jerom>
2. Click on 'Support this cause'.
3. Choose how you wish to sign up, using your Facebook or email details.
4. Once you have created your account, you are ready to shop. Just go to the easyfundraising website and search for your favourite retailers.

Matched Funding

Many companies offer their employees the chance to take part in a matched funding scheme. Companies may support the school in a variety of ways including: matching funds raised through an activity (e.g. school quiz); matching funds raised by a sponsored event; a cash donation; donation of equipment (i.e. playground equipment); donation of services; donation of prizes (suitable for raffles/auctions/tombola). Alternatively, a parent may opt to make a cash donation to the PTFA, which again could be matched by their organisation.

Whilst we can't organise 'physical' events at present, we are exploring what we might be able to organise online. **Please check whether your employer/organisation has a Matched Funding policy** and what it covers as this may be an easy way to double any amount you might help us raise.
