## **Important - Safe Parking around the school site**

I am disappointed that the school continues to receive complaints accompanied in some cases by photographic evidence from our neighbours with regard to school families parking inconsiderately in the local area. This week I have been provided with photographic evidence of a car parked not only inconsiderately but illegally in Sovereign Place.

I cannot emphasise enough the importance of parking safely for your child and other children accessing the school site. The ethos of being considerate to each other and our neighbours is fundamental to our School Values and the children are taught this constantly during their time in school. Leading by example is a way to reinforce this in your child's development.

Once again, we formally request that when bringing your child to school by car, all adults ensure that they adhere to local parking restrictions and park considerately.

I fully appreciate that the majority of our families do indeed park in a way that is both considerate and legal and we thank you for this. Of course, Tesco car park is available for this purpose and wherever possible we do encourage families to walk to school.

I trust we can rely on your attention to this matter and ask that you ensure any adult who is likely to bring or collect your child from school is aware of the contents of this letter.
