Dear Parent / Carer,

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you and your family for your support and perseverance this half term as most children have been learning at home.

I am absolutely delighted with the extremely high rate of participation and the progress that children are making despite the many challenges faced by learning remotely rather than being at school. We hope that you have found that the opportunities provided by our staff have engaged and supported learning during this period of extended school closure.

I am aware that some children were disappointed not to be able to access our celebration event this afternoon. We sincerely apologise for this technical issue that meant we could not admit more than 100 participants. The resources shared have been posted in google classrooms for children to enjoy. If any children were not able to share anything that they had prepared, we would actively encourage them to send photos or video clips to their year group home learning email so that these can be shared within google classrooms. We will review arrangements for such events in the future to ensure everyone can take part. Thank you for your understanding.

Remote Education provision and onsite provision for critical worker and vulnerable pupils will continue after half term until at least the 8th March. We await a final decision about the reopening of schools but will inform you of plans as soon as we receive guidance from the Department for Education. We know that all children made extremely rapid progress when they returned to school in September 2020 and we are entirely confident that after such positive experiences at home this term, they will do so again when it is safe to return to school.
