## **School reopening for all pupils on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March**

Further to my letter earlier in the week, I am writing to confirm that we will be reopening for all children on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. Staff will continue to offer Remote Education until Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March. Please note that on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> of March there will only be one google meet session for each year group in the morning, this is to enable staff to return to the school site and prepare classrooms and resources. Provision for children of critical workers will continue as usual. On return to school children will follow the same procedures that they were familiar with in the Michaelmas term.
